

# THE VICAR WRITES

Since last November the three Church Councils of the 'Three Towers Parishes' have been meeting together about every three months. The purpose of these meetings has been to explore how we can support one another, and also to consider the common challenges and opportunities we face. This has proved to be a very valuable exercise - and very enjoyable. Initially we discussed how the financial responsibility for the ministry of the parishes should be met. The three parishes have to pay a 'parish share' to the Diocese of Lincoln: recently we have been paying £32,000 a year and this is increasing to £36,000 or £3,000 a month. This money supports the ministry across the whole of Lincolnshire including here in our parishes. The sharing of this contribution was very straightforward involving a small adjustment.

Another area for discussion was how the Church Councils were responding to the changing provision of ministry as a result of the decision of the Church of England to move forward with ordaining women bishops. In January 2015 a

questionnaire was distributed to the 200 people on the electoral roll of the parishes which asked people for their views. The responses revealed a 50/50 divide between those who wished to embrace the new provision and those who would like to see a continuation of orthodox ministry in the parishes. It is up to each parish church council to vote on this issue and recently Edenham and Witham have both voted to ask the Bishop of Lincoln to help them maintain a traditional ministry in order to foster the optimum unity in church life. Representatives of these parishes have yet to see Bishop Christopher although it is expected he will continue asking Bishop Norman (the Provincial Visitor) to have a watching brief on what happens and visit us for our Confirmation and other special occasions

Looking to the future - those involved regularly in the worshipping life of our three parishes are very aware of the challenge of maintaining both the frequency and the content and style of the worship. These parishes are very unusual in providing a weekly service at the same time on a Sunday – these services (with a few exceptions) being Holy Communion. Most parishes with a population of 500 or less in our area may have one or two services a month. Given the change in social attitudes, the 'churn' in the make up of our village communities, as well as other factors affecting the number of those attending and the frequency of attendance, has stimulated a discussion about the future provision of weekly worship.

At our last get together we addressed this challenge by returning to fundamentals - we gathered around the Bible and we spent time in quiet prayer and reflection: then we shared any insights we had gained. In a remarkable expression of a common mind and heart the outcome was a deeper appreciation of the worship we shared, and a definite understanding that we must keep up our meeting together around the Lord's Table, praying and praising in spirit and in truth. There was a recognition that simple trust and obedience to Jesus in the present was all that really mattered. We were reminded that 'he who calls you is faithful' and 'why worry about tomorrow - today has

enough problems of its own'. If you are looking for a place of hope and peace then you will find it in a church near you!

#### **MUSIC AT EDENHAM CHURCH**

At the time of writing Edenham Church is still without a regular organist. If there is anyone who may be able to help with the leading of singing on a Sunday the Vicar would be very pleased to hear from them. There is a very good organ in Edenham Church but there is also an electric piano – but there are many other instruments which could lead and support the singing – before organs were in churches the parish would have a 'band' of anything that was available – we would quite happily go down this route!

- If you come across someone who is not breathing or breathing erratically, <u>the most</u> <u>important thing is to call</u> 112 or 999 <u>immediately</u> then start CPR.
- When you call **112** or **999**, tell the operator that you will be using the public access defibrillator & need the **code number**. Don't delay or interrupt chest compressions to get the defibrillator, send someone else.
- Once the defibrillator is open, all you have to do is follow the spoken instructions.

This is so simple and cheap to make, but as the flowers are only available for a very short season, it is imperative to be ready to make it quickly. I made it for the very first time last year and should have made it many years ago! It is so much nicer than the stuff you buy in the shops.

Citric acid can be bought from the chemist, and Campden tablets are used in beer and winemaking to kill off any yeast, so very important to use if you wish to keep the cordial for any length of time.

### **ELDERFLOWER CORDIAL**

25 ELDERFLOWER HEADS

**2 WHOLE SLICED LEMONS** 

1 ½ KG CASTER SUGAR

1 ½ LITRES WATER

**50G CITRIC ACID**

Pick flower heads that are just open, with no brown bits. Dissolve sugar in water & cool slightly. Put flowers & lemons in a container, pour over sugar syrup. Add citric acid & Campden tablets. Stir, cover, & leave in a cool place for 24 hours. Strain through a muslin cloth. Pour into sterilised bottles. Keeps for about 8 weeks. Dilute to taste. Once opened store in the fridge.
