

#### THE VICAR WRITES

'Life long learning' has been a catchall description of all kinds of adult education programmes and activities. To keep learning throughout life is easier said than done. For various reasons we can be turned off learning - it might be that our experience of school was almost entirely negative. It might be that in various ways we have been convinced that we are useless at it. It may be that we are quite content the way we are and don't want to learn anything new. There will be, of course, some readers who think they know it all already!

The first description of a Christian is a 'Disciple' – which simply means a 'learner'. The Christian never comes to the point where they stop learning.

The syllabus for the Christian stretches over every aspect of life and its core subjects include the Bible and the broader Christian Tradition. Furthermore, the Christian has to explore not only the area of intellect in building up knowledge and understanding but also enter into the mystery of spiritual experience. Christian Discipleship has an impact on every area of life-style. It is a whole-person, whole-life endeavour.

To describe the Christian life in these terms will be a puzzle to the majority of people. A quick glance at the written media and a channel hop across the broadcast media will reveal a rather tired disdain for religion in general and the Christian Faith in particular! This was illustrated recently by the proposal (by the presenters) to ditch 'Thought for Today' on Radio 4.

I am, of course, convinced that the Christian Faith stands up to the most robust examination from any intellectual discipline. I am more than willing to meet with anyone to discuss any issues arising from Christian ethics and teaching.

Lent is a six-week period set aside in the Church's year for stretching minds and souls and The Three Towers contains details of what's on offer in these parishes and the Deanery. If anyone would like any more details please get in touch.

#### See things in a new light at Edenham Regional House

We welcome individuals and groups from any Christian tradition or from none; for quiet days, retreats, study, workshops, meetings, training events, individually guided retreats, cell groups, Alpha away days and team meetings of all kinds including school governors and staff. #### What is a Retreat?

A retreat is exactly what it sounds like — the chance to step aside from life for a while, to rest and just 'be' in a welcoming, peaceful place. Retreats offer the opportunity to: find space, reflect, pray and worship in peaceful and comfortable surroundings. Some of them might involve different activities like walking or gardening. There are two types:

#### **Individually Guided Retreats**

These retreats are held in atmosphere of quiet and enable individuals (who are accompanied by an experienced prayer guide) to respond to the call of Christ in their lives. The days include a time of prayer and worship together, but is tailored to the needs of each individual.

#### **Conducted Retreat**

These retreats are more group focused and are conducted by a leader. They are usually held over a weekend or Mon-Fri. A typical day will involve 9am Morning Prayer, 10am Address (a talk lasting about 20 minutes), 12-noon Eucharist, 1pm Lunch, 4pm Address, 5.30pm Evening Prayer, 6.30pm Supper and 9pm Night Prayer. Suggested contribution of £175 or you can take a flexible approach to a traditional conducted retreat. If you find that you don't have the time to complete a whole retreat you can join us for 1 day or more and you don't have to stay over! You can pick any combination of days and just pay £22.50 per day with supper included! (£15 without supper).

#### Conducted Retreat: 12th - 16th March 2018

The Letters of St Peter, led by Father Andrew Hawes. #### 100 years ago this month

(From entries made by the Rev L H Cooley into the Parish Magazine—reproduced by kind permission of The Witham on the Hill Historical Society)

#### February 1918

The Day of Intercession was on the whole, well observed here. Unwontedly large congregations were present, and the special forms of service issued by authority were used throughout the day. The services, we are told, made a

deep impression on many. The collections (£1/6/6) were sent to the Red Cross Society. This solemn day must be the key-note for the year. We should try to make a far greater use of our weekly Intercession every Sunday at 11, and if it really is the case that we can come to one service only, let it be rather than in the evening.



In an article about Mr Thomas Pick of Elderwood, who has made a complete recovery after his long and critical illness, the following was included. "We feel also that we speak for all in saying how heartily we welcome Mr. Edgar Pick's return home, which happily coincided with the commencement of his father's improvement in health, and probably even contributed to it."

**The Social Evening**, organized by the Committee of the Reading Room (*Parish Hall*) on December 27th, realized a net profit of £9, £3 of which has been sent already to the Netley Hut Fund, to be followed by a further contribution at the end of the season, if the funds allow.


