



Commemoration of WWI in the Parish of Witham-on-the-Hill

The First World War saw 65 men and 1 woman from the area join the armed forces, mostly the Army but also the Navy and Royal Flying Corp. Of these, 15 died (23%). The following monthly extract is from the booklet compiled as a record of the war as seen by the parishioners at the time, in date order and in the language, grammar and sometimes spelling of the period. There is a heavy religious theme in all the entries by the Vicar, Canon Leonard Cooley, not surprising for a clergyman of the time. Entries are unedited, as it gives an interesting insight into the thinking of the time, from a social history view point.

The booklet was produced by Witham-on-the-Hill Historical Society (Incorporating Manthorpe, Toft and Lound). The Society is a registered charity - No. 1078244

100 years ago this month

(From entries made by the Rev L H Cooley into the Parish Magazine—reproduced by kind permission of The Witham on the Hill Historical Society)

November 1918

"The Turning of the Tide." - On August 4th we prayed for victory and peace. The nation was on its knees in a united effort of prayer greater and more universal than ever before. Since that day we have never looked back, our armies have gone from victory to victory. Can any thinking man fail to see the hand of God in all this? Our prayers have been answered, answered so wonderfully that we are filled with awe and gratitude. The great day is coming at last. Praise be to God! But we must not slacken effort, rather redouble it. We are asked not to talk or think too much of peace, lest, in that very way, we even hinder its coming.

The "Boys" - A large number of our soldier boys have recently been home on leave, among them have been J. Lound, F. Rawlings, W. Dalby, W. Archer, G. Archer, A. Pick, A. Francis, W. Haddon, and L. Harmston. It has been a real pleasure to see them, and to wish them God-speed and a safe and speedy return. By-the-bye, Christmas is on its way. Before long we shall

begin to think of those gifts which hitherto we have never failed to send them all at this festive season.








