

The Vicar Writes

I don't know about you but I feel like I could do with a rest! I've been so tired of late and I can't help but wonder why? I don't think I'm alone. Just the other day I was chatting with someone who felt that people just looked worn out. That said, if there's one thing that every human being longs for it has to be rest. We all long to 'rest in peace' not only when we die but also while we're very much alive. One of the most restful states of being we can know in our lives comes from being in what we might call the 'right relationship' with someone. Do you know what I mean? Whether it's a friendship, close personal relationship or part of a wider family group; when those relationships are working well , people are enjoying one another's company, help and support. It just feels 'right' and with that 'rightness' comes a sense of being 'at rest'. Contrast that with the anxiety and frustration that comes from being in a bad or damaged relationship with someone and you can readily see what I mean.

In St Matthew's Gospel (Matt 11.28-13), Jesus makes the claim that ultimate rest - the longing of every human heart for the most 'right' of all 'right relationships' - comes only through being in a right relationship with Him! That's quite a claim! "You want to rest?" says Jesus, "Come to me. I am the rest-giver. I'm the one you need to embrace." What I've always found reassuring about this restful invitation from Jesus is who he makes that invitation to and what he invites them to receive as a result. It's worth noting that Jesus doesn't invite those who have found their own sense of self-worth, the self-satisfied or the self-righteous, nor does he invite those who are living a life of ease and plenty. No, Jesus invites "all who labour and are heavy laden" (v.28). He invites the tired, the needy, the frustrated, the anxious, and those who feel like they have it 'all to do'.

But what does he invite them to? Rest? Yes! But more than that. Jesus invites them to "take his yoke" upon them. We all know what a yoke is; it's an instrument of work! It's a wooden frame designed to distribute weight in equal proportions to both sides of the body in order to make a load or burden easier to carry. So why promise us a yoke? Well, the truth is that Jesus doesn't promise us an escape from reality in turning to him. He won't suspend time so that we can enjoy a long weekend by the pool. What he

Witham on the Hill WI

We are so proud of our members who have been knitting and sewing headbands, uniform bags and scrubs for the NHS.

We hope all our members have felt supported by the committee and other members and look forward to meeting-up together.

Toft cum Lound and Manthorpe Parish Council Update

The last three months have been difficult and challenging for us all but it seems that now is a good time to start thinking about the future. As a council, we are keen to be able to follow up on items we had identified before lockdown.

One such item is that of regenerating our playing field. The brief we as Councillors have set ourselves is to provide an area where all residents can enjoy some form of play and/or exercise. Creating spaces where children can play freely requires careful thought and imaginative design. The challenge is to provide the best possible play opportunities, and to create play spaces that will be attractive for children, capture their imagination and give them scope to play in new and exciting ways.



Some months ago, a group of children in our parish suggested ways to improve the playground facility. We agreed this was a good idea and to date have spoken with two suppliers of equipment in order to produce a budget for such works. We estimate we would require £25k to procure some new items suitable for children of all ages and abilities. We are setting ourselves a funding target of £35k which would provide flexibility when choosing the new equipment to cater for both adults and children.

We also aim to ensure that the space where our children play is an important social place for our community, not just for children and young people, but also for parents and the wider community. Parents can establish their own networks through their children, meaning that play also supports community cohesion amongst adults.

Our key concern is that we create a new facility without losing its familiar feeling and quality. The heritage of the place has to be respected, and the local rural village identity needs to be reflected in the overall design.

In order to gain funding we need to demonstrate to the potential funder that there is indeed interest and support within our community. We will therefore in the near future be seeking your views and ideas for this project. We look forward to your input – by doing so you will help us achieve something which will provide a legacy for future generations.

100 years ago

Memorials to the Missing

"He is not missing, he is here." Field Marshal Lord Plumer at the unveiling of the Menin Gate Memorial, July 1927

The memorials to the Missing gave the individual architects scope to try to express the enormity of the human sacrifice made. The first to be commissioned and completed was Blomfield's magnificent memorial in Ypres, The Menin Gate Memorial, which commemorates the names of more than 55,000 men on 1200 panels. Other memorials followed:

Tyne Cot in Belgium designed by Sir Herbert Baker; the Helles Memorial on Gallipoli designed by Sir John Burnet; the Thiepval Memorial on the Somme is the work of Sir Edwin Lutyens while the Missing in Salonika are commemorated at Lake Doiran on a monument by Sir Robert Lorimer. Later, individual member states erected memorials to their own country's dead: the Canadians at Vimy Ridge, the Australians at Villers Bretonneux and the South Africans at Delville Wood.

POPPY SEED & HONEY CAKE WITH STRAWBERRY ICING

100g caster sugar
175g butter
85g honey
3 eggs
140g s r flour
25g cornflour
2 tablespoons poppy seeds
100g icing sugar
2 tablespoons strawberry puree

Butter a large ring tin (approx 8ins) dust with a spoonful of flour & caster sugar. Tap out excess. Cream butter, honey & sugar until pale & fluffy. Beat in eggs. Add dry ingredients & fold in. Spoon into tin & level the surface. Bake 160c for approx 35 mins until risen & firm. Cool in tin for 10 mins then ease sides with a palette knife & turn onto wire rack to cool. Make the puree by crushing a handful of strawberries & pushing through a sieve to remove pips. Mix icing sugar & puree to make a stiff icing – use more icing sugar if necessary. Put a plate under the cooling rack to catch the drips. Drizzle the icing over the cooled cake, & decorate with fresh strawberries. Can be served with cream, crème fraiche or even ice cream!
