Minutes of a Parish Council Meeting Held at Toft Hotel on 3 Jul 2013 at 1930

<u>Declarations of Acceptance of Office/Interests Register.</u> There were no declared conflicts of interest based on the agenda items.

<u>Minutes of the last Meeting.</u> The minutes of the last meeting on 8 May 2013 were accepted as a true copy.

Matters Arising.

1. "Rabbits were still a problem in the Playing Field and the children's slide mound was, in a dangerous state".

Parish Councillors have visited the site and reported that there are some low level holes. These are not considered dangerous or excessive. Indeed the position is improving after holes were previously filled. The grass cutters will be asked to fill holes and Parish Councillor volunteers will fill holes and seed the area.

2. "Bothorpe Park Farm. Continuous white line on road to stop overtaking". Mr Cork has written to Highways requesting consideration for a continuous white line to be installed. After receiving a holding reply, and amidst some confusion regarding a double white line, the request was rejected. The reason was insufficient criteria to install a line and doing so would dilute the impact of white lines in other locations. The County Councillor will be asked to raise the topic directly with Highways.

1. Proposed change to library provision in Lincs. Manthorpe mobile library service is to stop from May 2014. Details will be placed on Parish website and await any comments from community.

AOB. The following was discussed:

The A6121 has recently been surface dressed with gravel. Mr McWilliams asked if Highways could be contacted with a view to sweeping the loose gravel that had migrated off the A6121 onto the road leading into Manthorpe. It was also asked if the road was subsequently swept of the loose gravel as road surface seems poor with not

all gravel adhering to road surface. Thus there is a risk of damage to vehicles from flying stone chips. In addition, the edges of the road have considerable quantities of loose gravel which creates a problem for cyclists. The Clerk was asked to write to Highways to see what can be done.
