

THE VICAR'S WRITES

Christianity as a religion is one that embraces life in all its many aspects. The puritan approach to The Faith which is a list of inhibitions 'don't do this and don't do that' is a gross misrepresentation. Jesus promised 'I come that you may have life and have it in all its fullness'. There is also a freedom to be found in the Christian Faith which comes from knowing liberty of the fear of death, and a sure knowledge that, in Jesus, the Creator has also revealed himself to be a healer and reconciler. As we hear in Church on Christmas Day 'the grace of God has dawned with healing in its wings'.

The Christmas Festival gladly embraces humanity's capacity for celebration. The wonderful words and music of carols; the distinctive richness of Christmas food and drink; the gathering of family and friends and a spirit of openness to others, are entirely at one with the celebration of Him who 'was from the beginning and through whom all things were made.' Jesus is indeed a guest at our tables –

table fellowship was a huge part of his life and ministry.

The Christian Faith carries one clear duty which is particularly pertinent at Christmas this duty is set out in the main prayer of the Eucharist (Mass) –'it is our duty and our joy at all times to be thankful'. EPIPHANY CAROL SERVICE
The season of Christmas ends on January 6th – the full title of the day is 'The Epiphany of Our Lord to the Gentiles' – this means the revealing or disclosure of Jesus as Lord to the non-Jewish world. In 2013 it falls on a Sunday and there will be an Epiphany Carol Service in Edenham Church at 4.00pm. Afterwards the Vicarage family invite everyone for a final taste of

Christmas!

CONFIRMATION

Next year's Parish Confirmation will take place on Sunday 21st April at 10.30am in Edenham Parish Church. Preparation for this will begin in the New Year. There are usually two separate groups that prepare for confirmation; one for adults and one for youngsters (10-13 years old). If there are any 'inbetweeners' there is usually a separate group for them. The aim is to have at least ten sessions before the confirmation; in addition there are follow up meetings to this, that run-on until the summer holidays. The minimum age is ten, there is no maximum. It is often the case that some candidates are also baptised at the same time as Confirmation. The sessions assume that candidates are approaching the Christian Faith with an open and enquiring mind and the assumption is that we will 'start from scratch'. Anyone who is at all interested should contact one of the clergy. If you are confirmed and would like a 'refresher' you are welcome to join in. Taking part in the course does not commit

SERVICE OF LIGHT

This will take place at St Andrew's Witham on the 2nd December at 6.00pm. This will be the traditional service for Advent Sunday – the first day of the four-week season in preparation for Christmas. It anticipates the coming into the world of Christ the Light. The service begins in darkness and, whilst the carols and readings unfold the fulfilment of God's promises throughout history, the church becomes filled with light as the flame of one candle becomes the source of light for hundreds. This service will be ticket only. This is for two reasons: first, the layout of the building and the preparation of the candles will depend on the numbers attending; secondly, seasonal refreshments will be served afterwards and tickets will determine how much

baking is done! Tickets from the Vicarage, or after any service. Tickets are £2 for adults and free for children – who will still need a ticket!

THE REGIONAL HOUSE



Summary of the Minutes of Edenham PCC - 6th November 2012

9 present, 3 apologies

Church Building: The alarm on the roof has been tested and is working. The churchwarden met with English Heritage Architect & David Pitts, the first round of the application for a grant of £100,000 towards the repair to the roof costing £150,000 has been completed.

Accounts: Both income and expenditure in line with budget, but it was decided to renew the Stewardship campaign in 2015 on the completion of any appeal.

Fund raising: Following poor response to an email request for

help, it was agreed a letter be sent to all parishioners in the New Year, setting out the repair needs of the Church and its financial consequences.

Regional House is to receive a visitation from Reverend Philip North, Bishop Designate of Whitby, in order to carry out a review of the House at the request of Bishop Christopher.

Reports of various ministries were received re Church School, Sunday School, Youth Group. Reports were also received from Licensed reader & Assistant Curate.

Christmas Greetings Board in Church: Proceeds this year to go to "The Bible Society".

Notes from the Edenham Parish Council Meeting 13th November

The condition of the Elsthorpe/ Grimsthorpe Road and the trees on verge opposite Black Horse, Grimsthorpe, were reported to Highways.

PCSO Nielander briefed that vehicle fuel and 4x4 utility vehicle thefts, along with poaching, are the main concerns in the parish. Anyone seeing any suspicious activity, however minor, is requested to contact the Police using the '101' police number.

Children's Play Area - Annual Safety Inspection and ground maintenance invoices paid.

Annual External Audit - Audit Report for the year 2011/12 from Clement Keyes Accountants was accepted.

Annual Maintenance Grants - Grants awarded to Edenham PCC and Village Hall/Playing Field towards maintenance (£200 each).

Parish Precept 2013/4 - Budget set and precept agreed at £2750.

Cllr Biggs reported on his initial investigation into the provision of

an emergency defibrillator for the parish. Council agreed to support the project subject to satisfactory grant and fund raising to meet initial setup costs (approx £2000). Cllr Biggs volunteered to progress grant applications etc – to report at next meeting.

Highway Matters - Potholes by Scoth Farm Cottages and 10 Church Lane, Edenham; damage to verges along Grimsthorpe – Elsthorpe – Edenham roads and mud/debris on Bulby Road, Elsthorpe, to be reported to Highways and the Police.

Bulb Planting - Thanks to local resident, Mrs Ruth Atter, for helping to improve the appearance of the local area by planting daffodil bulbs throughout the parish.

The next meeting of the Edenham Parish Council will take place on Tuesday 8th January 2013 at 7:30pm in Edenham Village Hall.

Parish Council Meetings take place on the second Tuesday in every other month - Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep, Nov at 7:30pm in Edenham Village Hall.

Notes of the Swinstead Parish Council meeting, 1st November.

Liaison with Multi-Agencies: Diary Sheets would continue to be used. Closer liaison between Swinstead Parish Council and the agencies would be maintained. The Council will receive quarterly reports from the Police and SKDC.

Correspondence: It was decided not to permit a request to allow sheep to graze in the football field.

The Council agreed to a planning application for crown reduction of the walnut tree at 20 High Street.

Butter Cross: A second set of letters inviting tenders for the work had been sent out but no responses had been received to date.

The Diamond Jubilee Community Wildlife Orchard: Six trees have been planted and a further 30 have been ordered for potting over the winter and planting during 2013. The Wildlife Grant Application had received favourable feed-back and final costings were now required for the boundary gate, stakes and tree guards. Thanks were given to Cllr. Clive Lunn for the cutting of the grass in the Community Orchard.

Dog Fouling and Loose Dogs: Labels will be attached to the village

litter bins indicating that residents may use them to dispose of dog excrement. Some residents are concerned about dogs not on the lead. Dog owners should remember that some younger children and residents are frightened of dogs. The Council will monitor this situation and may make arrangements with SKDC for the Dog Warden to patrol the village if necessary.

Parish Walk-About: Noted that extended kerbing on the B1176 New Estate was "desirable". Work on the drainage channel on the Bourne Road and repairs to damaged cambers on Forstedd Hill were agreed as well as visits from the jetting machine and road sweeper. A corner kerb in Croake Hill requires re-installation. Replacement street signage for New Estate, Main Road and Park Road has been ordered.

Grass Cutting at the Football Field: Tenders are required for 7 monthly cuts between the months of April and October.

Speeding: The Road Safety Partnership will be asked to monitor the speed of traffic using the B1176.


